The following is meant to provide information on how you can send us your materials to be considered for our exhibition calendar.

Taller's fundamental credo for its visual arts program is based on the constant evaluation of art, in particular, the artistic/cultural representation of Puerto Rico and Latin America. We aim to present quality exhibitions with a strong educational component that is relevant to the students and audiences we serve. We believe in looking at the history that is embedded in the past as the basis for our educational discourse, but with eyes in the present as a bridge to the future. Artists whose works challenge contemporary stereotypes and/or limitations, and who project a solid understanding of the roots of our traditions within a contemporary context are ideal contributors for the gallery's vision and mission. For Artists interested in showcasing work, please note we look at every submission and take them into consideration. Our exhibitions are chosen based on a themed annual season and are scheduled three years in advance. Artists may be asked to work in residency so please let us know of your experience and interest in working in residencies and providing workshops for varied age groups.

For submissions please send 5 - 10 jpegs on a disc or in an e-mail along with a biography, resume, and artist statement. Please include any experience you may have in artist residencies or teaching. Please do not call to inquire about your submission. If you are chosen, we will contact you to discuss your availability and other details.

Rejection is not a reflection of the quality or integrity of your work. There are many factors that dictate what we show, including the fact that we only feature 3 to 4 exhibits each year and that we get many requests. Receiving your material does not guarantee that you will be included in our calendar.
